Advanced Academics

Students enrolled in Brownwood High School have the opportunity to participate in wide variety of PreAP and Advanced Placement courses in grades 9-12. Additionally, students are able to enroll in Dual Credit coursework through Texas State Technical School, Ranger College, and Howard Payne University. BHS also offer multiple Dual Enrollment courses through the University of Texas OnRamps Program.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE AND RANKING CALCULATION

Class Rank and Quartile are reported unless the student makes a formal request to have it withheld from his or her transcript. Class rank for students entering grade 9 in the 2017-18 school year (the 2021 cohort class) is established by a GPA calculated from the summation of grade points earned in all courses during grades 9-12. For student who entered grade 9 in the 2018-19 school year (the 2022 cohort class) and thereafter, the District shall include in the calculation of class rank semester grades earned in high school credit courses taken in the following core subject areas only: English, mathematics, science, and social studies. For all students, only the first attempt at a course is figured into GPA. Grades earned for credit recovery are not calculated in GPA. Dual credit courses completed in the fall, spring, or summer are also included in the GPA calculations. Correspondence courses, summer school courses and credit by exam courses are not included in the GPA. The following weighted system is used to determine the GPA:

AWARDING CREDIT

A student completing a full credit course who fails one semester and passes the other semester may receive full credit if the average of the two semesters is 70 or above.
